

## Chapter Twenty-Two (b): Deleting a User Group

### Summary of Chapter:

- How to delete a 'Group' on your NetPilot

### What you need:

- Knowledge of admin user account and valid password for your NetPilot.

### Software Revision Required:

- Applicable to software revision 4.1.4 > NetPilots

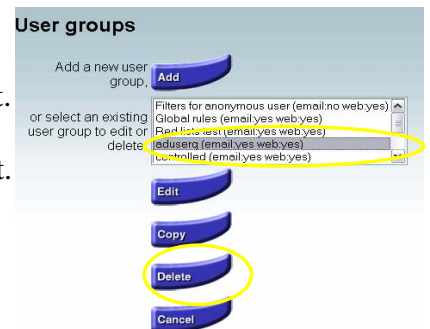
### Deleting a Group:

- Log on to the NetPilot as shown in Chapter One (b).

- Select the 'User Account' button on the left-hand side of the screen, then the 'Group' button at the top of the screen, (both of the buttons are highlighted below).



- You will be presented with this screen.



- Select the 'Group' that you want to delete, as highlighted on the right.

- Then select the 'Delete' button, which is also highlighted on the right.

- Select 'OK' and 'OK' again.

- If there are still 'Users' in the 'Group' your NetPilot will not allow you to 'Delete' the group, as shown below.



- You will need to relocate the 'Users' to another 'Group'. (Please see Chapter 9 and the other section of Chapter 22 for more information).

- Then once there are no more 'Users' assigned to the 'Group' you can go through the above process to delete the 'Group'.
