- 🔗 Applicable to software revision 5.1.4 > NetPilots

Allowing FTP with the Advanced Firewall:

- 🔗 Log on to the NetPilot as shown in Chapter One (b).
- 🔗 From the left-hand side of the screen, select 'Firewall' and then 'Firewall Overview'. (All links are highlighted below).




- 🔗 Select the 'Trusted/Internet' link from the firewall table as highlighted above.


- 🔗 You will be presented with the below screen:



- 🔗 Select the 'Show advanced firewall' tick box as highlighted left.

- 🔗 Select 'OK'


